



# North American Corriente Association

2017 Board Meeting  
May 22, 2017 7pm MT

President Ricky Mara called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm MT.

Board Members present: Ricky Mara, Douglas Dale, Calvin Schwartz, Dale Nauman; Advisor Tucker Ashley and Executive Director Ellen Hamilton was also present.

1. Voting for the open position on the Board of Directors replacing Dale Nauman has begun and will close on June 15<sup>th</sup>. Results will be announced in Graham Texas.
2. The wording on the Visual Inspection of a Bull form was changed to clarify that bulls will be more heavily scrutinized than cows.
3. Motion was made by Douglas, seconded by Calvin and passed that the price of a visual inspection of a bull be raised immediately to \$2,500. If the bull does not pass \$1,000 will be refunded.
4. Motion was made by Dale, seconded by Douglas and passed to raise the price for the visual inspection of cows to \$75 starting July 1, 2017.
5. Show Entries are up this year – 100 head currently for confirmation, 12 for Get of Sire, 50 for Roping. It's going to be a great show!
6. Discussion was held on making a Youth Class **sanctioned** – Douglas discussed the value of the youth class in recent Meridan, MS shows, and the long term interest it develops in the youth. Further discussions were held over such issues as how many heifers one youth could show, and minimum requirements to be sanctioned.

Motion was made by Douglas, seconded by Dale and passed: The Youth Yearling Heifer class will be sanctioned and results will appear on the animal pedigree if the minimum requirements of 6 animals or more are in the class. (The youth class must meet the same requirements to be sanctioned as other classes) No limit was made on how many animals one youth can show per class.
